1 Many things

Plural mit -s: brother – *brothers*, day – *days*,

dream – *dreams*, tree – *trees*

Plural mit -es: beach – *beaches*, church – *churches*,

lunch – *lunches*, glass – *glasses*

Plural mit -ies: diary – *diaries*, party – *parties*,

balcon – *balconies*, story – *stories*

Plural ohne Regel: woman – *women*, mouse – *mice*,
fish – *fish*, child – *children*

2 An afternoon in the garden

- 1 The Scott family and the Kiefer family are together. The two *families* are in the garden.
- 2 Andrea can see a mouse under the tree. There are lots of *mice* in the garden.
- 3 There are *fish* in the pond. One fish is really big.
- 4 The *children* are hungry and one child is very hungry.
- 5 Emma has a pizza box. There are more pizza *boxes* in the kitchen.

3 Charlie

I **feed** (feed) Charlie before school. He **eats** (eat) a lot! Then he **plays** (play) in the garden and **watches** (watch) the birds. Before lunch he **goes** (go) to the shops with Mum. After school we **play** (play) football with him in the garden. In the evening Mum and Dad **go** (go) for a walk with him. They **throw** (throw) his ball and he **catches** (catch) it – but not always. He **runs** (run) away with the ball and Mum and Dad can't find it. That's Charlie's favourite game. He **has** (have) a new ball every week. In the evening we **play** (play) games. Charlie **falls** (fall) asleep in his basket – or on my bed!

4 It's the same every day!

- 1 I **have** a shower every morning, Luke **has** a shower every evening.
- 2 I **do** my homework in the afternoon, Luke **does** his homework in the evening.
- 3 I **clean** my room every day, and Luke **cleans** his room every week.
- 4 I **go** to the rabbit hutch, Luke **goes** to his friends.
- 5 I **play** with my rabbits, Luke **plays** football with his friends.

5 Our Sundays

- a) First, we **have** breakfast together in the kitchen. Mum **makes** tea and toast. Dad **eats** lots of marmalade. Toby **likes** cornflakes. After breakfast we **go** to the park with Happy. Emily **goes** too. Then we **help** Mum with lunch. Well, Dad **watches** TV, or he **reads** his newspapers. After lunch Toby and Happy **sleep**. Emily **talks** to all her friends on her mobile phone. In the evening we **listen** to music or we **watch** TV. I really **like** Sundays.
