10 Erin's new house

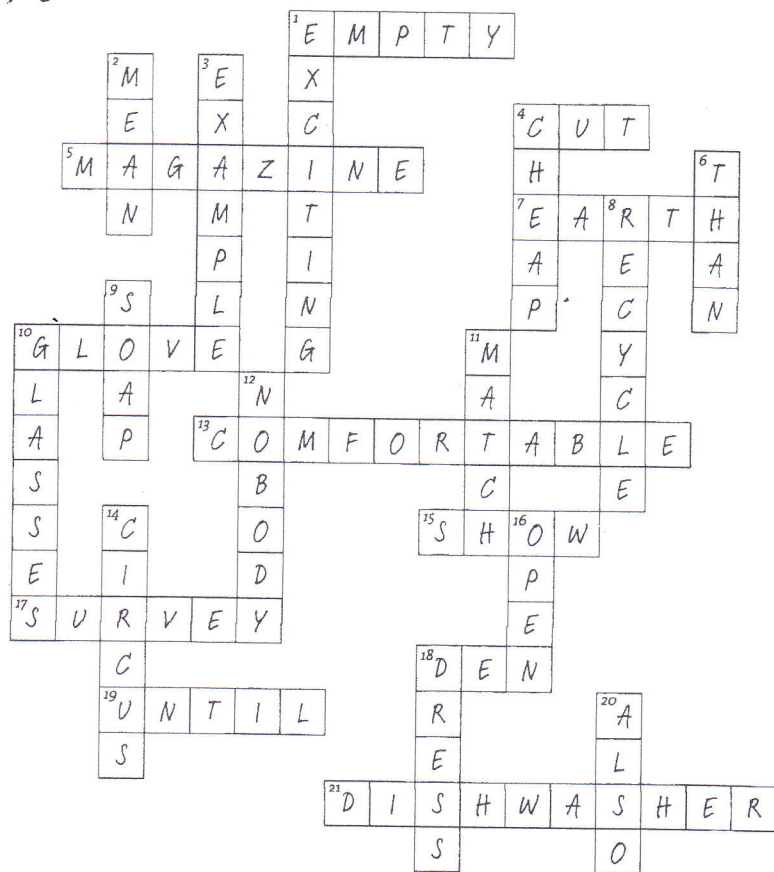
